

# CVI's and Livestock Permits



What are they and why do we need them?

- CVI or Certificate of Veterinary Inspection
- Requirement for all interstate travel
- Official document certifying that the animal was inspected and not showing any signs of disease or infection.
- Done by your local livestock vet

What is a livestock entry permit and why do we need them?

- An entry permit can also be called a movement permit or transport permit.
- It is not valid for crossing state lines or ownership changes
- Is given to you by the state you are going to and the permit number is put on your CVI
- It is an additional level of protection for the state to regulate what is coming into their state
